Craft, Design, and Technology - Additional time is available for any pupils to get some extra support in the classroom or access to workshop facilities. Pupils can come in over any lunchtime or after school, but MUST arrange this with their teacher ahead of time.

Physical Education – Students are encouraged to book lunchtime/after school help sessions with their teachers. Closer to exam and prelim dates, staff will offer regular help session times to their classes.
