2. Not all subjects and levels will be assessed during this period; some will utilise timetabled periods at different times over the year or have their own specific arrangements.
3. Where you have two different exams timetabled for the same date and time, you should liaise with your subject teachers to arrange an alternative time for the subject that you do not want to do at the timetabled slot.

Prelim Examinations – Student Conduct

Prelim examinations are important examinations. They allow you to judge your progress within a subject, and allow you and your teachers to predict your future attainment and may be used as the basis of information for Exceptional Circumstances Requests.

It is therefore expected that conduct in the examination rooms is of the highest standard, allowing all students to demonstrate their maximum level of performance.

Examination Conduct

Do:

- Ensure that you know the location and time of each examination.
- Make sure you arrive in good time for each examination.
- Sit in the assigned seat, if appropriate.
- Only leave the examination when indicated to by the invigilator, you may be required to remain in examination hall for the full duration of the exam.
- Bring appropriate equipment, e.g. pen, pencil, ruler, calculator, dictionary (where permitted).
- Listen carefully to any special instructions issued by the invigilator/teacher.
- Complete all rough working on examination booklet or paper provided for that purpose.
- Leave bags in designated areas.
- Wear normal school uniform.
- Return to class after each exam.

Don't:

- Take in any unauthorised aids, e.g. books, notes, paper, mobile phones, spellcheckers, etc.
- Communicate with or give assistance to any other candidates.
- Cause a disturbance in the examination room.
- Remove examination materials from the room.
